

Brady Bio

Nathan Brady Crain is a full-time professional singer/songwriter and stand-up comic from Vermont. He tours the US in a VW Vanagon Westfalia that he retrofitted to run on a matrix of gasoline and hydrogen that the vehicle generates for itself.

As a musician and songwriter, Brady (sometimes with his band Citizen Crain) combines encyclopedic musical influences (Cash, Beatles, Nelson, Taylor, Dylan, Charles, Johnson, Albeniz, and many more) to create upbeat original looped Americana.

What this means is that Brady writes great blues, folk, rock, bluegrass, country, country-blues, and rockabilly with skiffle, jazz, classical, and flamenco influences, and then uses several digital looping stations to create performance layers of percussion, bass, guitar, lead guitar, and three part harmonies during the performance of a given song (nothing is pre-recorded, the layering is part of the performance). This is truly a unique and amazing experience, not to be missed.

When he is not on tour nationally or performing shows regionally, Brady is often performing benefits for local Vermont food shelves.
